


Connect the TV plate (C) to the back of the TV











B Connect the 4 adaptors (D) to the TV plate and reassemble the screws.












Connect the TV plate with the adaptors to the TV in all 4 connection holes. Fully tighten screws A but connect screws B without tightening them fully.








Mark the holes on the ceiling according to the required position













7a 17" – 38.9" Connect the pipes according to the desired length. Each connection is made with 43cm – 99cm two Y1 screws and two Y2 nuts.


Important – You must assemble all three tubes, do not omit the middle tube T2. If necessary, you may insert the middle tube T2 in its entirety into the upper tube T1.



3 pipes 5 height level options:

Level	Height (inch)	Height (cm)
1	17"	43
2	22.7"	58
3	28.2"	72
4	33.7"	86
5	38.9"	99










Connect the pipes according to the desired length. Each connection is made with two Y1 screws and two Y2 nuts.


Important – You must assemble all five tubes, do not omit the middle tube T2. If necessary, you may insert both of the middle tubes T2 in their entirety into the upper tubes T1 and T4.









Attach the nut-housings (P2) to the lower pipe (T5). Make sure that the tab is inserted into the slot.




Push parts P3 down on the nut-housings (P2). The upside down "T" must pass the protruding tooth (shown below).






Insert and tighten the screws from both sides to create friction for the tilt mechanism. Adjust the TV tilt angle carefully.












Remove the screws and lift the TV







BACKSCREEN CONNECTION POSITIONING OPTIONS


All TV backscreen connections are in millimeters (Width × Height).


There are a few sizes of TV plates available.


The backscreen connections in position 1 are included in some of the different TV plates, according to their size, and do not require the use of the 4 adapters (marked in blue).








